

# Tableau des doigtés pour le cor simple en Fa et en Si b

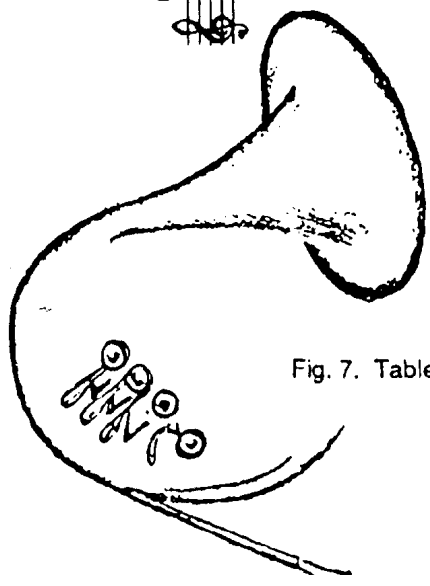


Fig. 7. Tableau de doigtés.
